Drama a story that is meant to be performed
■ Comes from the Greek Word, "
■ Means " <u>to do</u> " or <u>"</u> +v act "
■ The Doing/Acting Makes Arama
Elements of Drama
■ Pauoriant -the author of a play
■ – the written story available for everyone involved in performing
■ (Actors) (Castthe people who perform
■ <u>Cets</u> - the units of action
■ <u>Scenes</u> - parts of the acts
■ Characterization -playwright's technique for making believable characters
Dramatic Speech
■ Clialegue -conversation between or among characters
■ Morologue - long speech by one single character (private thoughts)
<u>Stage Directions</u> - notes in a script that describe how it should be performed (not spoken aloud when read)
■ Often found in
■ Describe Scenery , orcos and how characters
act . speak and/or move

Theater: where a play takes place
: construction on the stage that shows time/place
■ Could be called <u>5Cenery</u>
2 : Small movable items that the actors use to make actions look real
A speaker who helps to tell the story (usually not a character)
■ Normally used to give an introduction to the act
or 5Cent
