Assignment: Write a children's picture book based on an original fractured version of a fairy tale (be sure your group has read the original fairy tale!)

- 1) Plot triangle of your group story*
- 2) Write rough draft. Your story will be roughly 16-20 pages in length. (8-10 pages of text and 8-10 picture pages).*
- 3) Create an original e-book using the app Book Creator*
- 4) Share your story with your classmates.*

Important things to remember:

- 1) Your target audience is young children, 5-7 years old.
- 2) Your purpose is to teach a lesson to and entertain your young audience.
- 3) Be sure your book is appropriate in content, illustrations, and theme.

1. Group leader will create a Google doc, title it "____period, Group ____, title of story"
Example: 5th period, Group 3, Little Blue Riding Hood

3. Now you can all work on this document at once. This is your rough draft. Everyone needs to contribute to the creation of this story in a positive, collaborative way.
