

## WHAT IS A FRAGMENT?

- A fragment is a group of words that is punctuated as a sentence but is NOT a sentence.
- A fragment may be missing a subject.
- A fragment may be missing a verb.
- A fragment does not express a complete thought.

Went to the game. (Who went to the game? No subject!)

My very best friend. (Friend did what? No verb!)

When we arrive. (What happens? Not a complete thought!)
